Dr. Roy Lauter

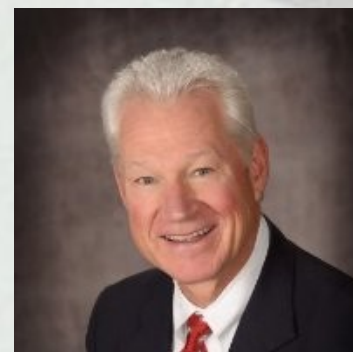

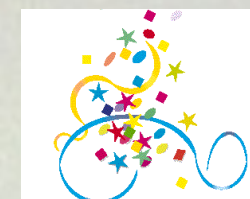

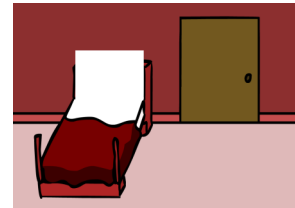
